RULE SUMMARY

The Columbia River Compact Agencies of Oregon and Washington will meet jointly to consider amendment of rules related to 1) commercial fishing in the Columbia River below Bonneville Dam and select areas; 2) treaty Indian commercial, subsistence and ceremonial fishing in the Columbia River above Bonneville Dam; and 3) sport fishing in the mainstem Columbia River.

Additional regulations concerning the maximum size limit for green sturgeon in statewide commercial fisheries will also be considered. *and tributaries of the JCL / 12-19-05*

Housekeeping and technical corrections to the regulations may occur to ensure rule consistency. The agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing the negative economic impact of the rule on business.
