

Agenda Item Summary

BACKGROUND

The Commission is authorized to allocate bighorn sheep, Rocky Mountain goat, pronghorn, deer and elk tags to be auctioned and raffled annually to benefit wildlife management, habitat management, and hunter access in Oregon. The auction and raffle of bighorn sheep, Rocky Mountain goat, and pronghorn tags generate funding for management and research for respective species, while deer and elk tags generate revenue for the Access and Habitat Program.

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT

The auction and raffle program provides public involvement through the opportunity for a unique hunting experience with an expanded hunt area and expanded season dates. Funds raised through the auction and raffle of big game tags are used to manage big game populations and their habitat and provide public hunting access on private lands.

ISSUE 1

2008 Auction and Raffle Tag Allocations

ANALYSIS

The Access and Habitat Board and ODFW staff recommend that Auction and Raffle hunts for 2008 remain unchanged from 2007 seasons.
