Light Boat and Brail Logbook Instructions

- You may print as many logbook pages as necessary or request printed pages by calling ODFW Marine Resources Program Newport office at 541-867-4741. An electronic file is available for printing at: https://www.dfw.state.or.us/MRP/regulations/commercial_fishing/index.asp
- Complete a log for each trip you make, including unsuccessful trips.
- Include time spent holding locations for day sets as well as time spent attracting squid by light. If these two activities occur sequentially at the same location, you may combine in a single row on the logbook page.
- **Lights used** – Print the type of light (sodium, incandescent, metal halide, light emitting diode (LED), other), amount of light generated by each individual bulb, and number of bulbs for each type. Please indicate if light is for use underwater (submerged) by adding S to type (for example, "S-metal halide").
- **Scoop capacity** – Print the circumference (distance around the circle), depth of bag in feet and an estimate of average pounds of squid taken per scoop.
- **Start date/time** – Print the date (dd/mm/yy; please include the year) and time that lighting or holding (for day sets) began at the location. For time, please use 24-hour format (for example, use 13:00 or 1300 instead of 1:00 pm).
- **Stop date/time** – Print the date and time that lighting or holding (for day sets) ended at the location.
- **Location** – Print the Latitude/Longitude coordinates of the activity. Please use degrees/decimal minutes and include at least two decimal places for minutes. If another format is used, please give a clear indication of the format.
- **Name of seiners that set squid** – Print the vessel name of each seiner you worked with to set squid at the location between the start and stop times. If more than two, print additional vessel names on the next row. Do not enter a unique row for each seiner.
- **Squid brailed** – Print an estimate of the pounds of squid taken and delivered by this vessel using brail or dipnet gear. Leave blank if you are operating solely as a light boat.
- **Captain's signature** – Captain must sign all logbook pages to show information is complete, accurate, and truthful
- Logbooks are **due to ODFW by the 10th of the month** following lighting or searching activity. Please return copies of your logbook sheets (originals or photocopies) to:
