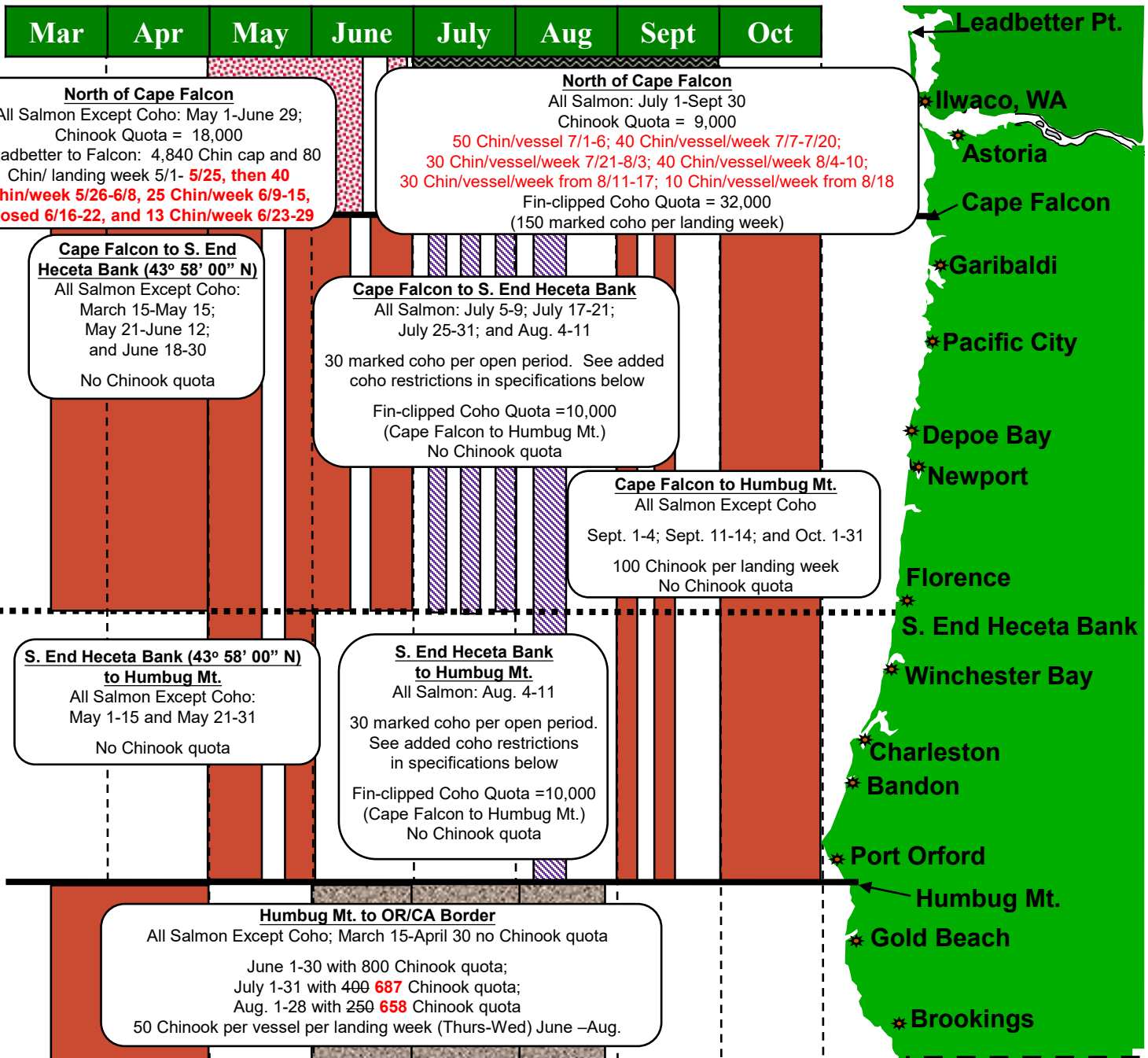







# Oregon Ocean Commercial Troll Salmon Seasons, 2022



**Additional Specifications:** Single-point barbless hooks required in all seasons, no more than 4 spreads per wire in all seasons from Cape Falcon to the OR/CA Border, landing week defined as Thurs.- Wed., and minimum lengths of 28" for Chinook S. of Falcon, 27" for Chinook N. of Falcon, and 16" for coho. Regulations as approved by PFMC, these still must be approved by Dept. of Commerce.

-  All salmon except coho. Vessels landing south of Leadbetter Pt., WA may only fish South of Leadbetter Pt. Vessels fishing north of Leadbetter Pt., must land their catch north of Leadbetter Pt. Landings restricted to within the open area and Garibaldi only. Must land all catch within 24 hours of any closure. Mandatory call-in for all landings into Oregon within an hour of delivery or prior to transport away from port at (541)857-2546 or by email to [nfalcon.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov](mailto:nfalcon.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov)
-  All salmon, all coho must be marked with a healed adipose fin clip. Vessels landing south of Leadbetter Pt., WA may only fish south of Leadbetter Pt. Vessels fishing north of Leadbetter Pt., must land their catch north of Leadbetter Pt. Landings restricted to within the open area and Garibaldi only. Must land all catch within 24 hours of any closure. Mandatory call-in for all landings into Oregon within an hour of delivery or prior to transport away from port at (541)857-2546 or to [nfalcon.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov](mailto:nfalcon.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov)
-  All salmon except coho. All fish must be landed into Oregon. In September and October, no more than 100 Chinook per landing week.
-  All salmon, all coho must be marked with a healed adipose fin clip. No more than 30 coho per open period, and all coho in possession and landed must not exceed a 1:1 ratio with Chinook in possession and landed.
-  All salmon except coho. All fish must be landed into Port Orford, Gold Beach, or Brookings within 24 hours of any closure in the fishery.
