

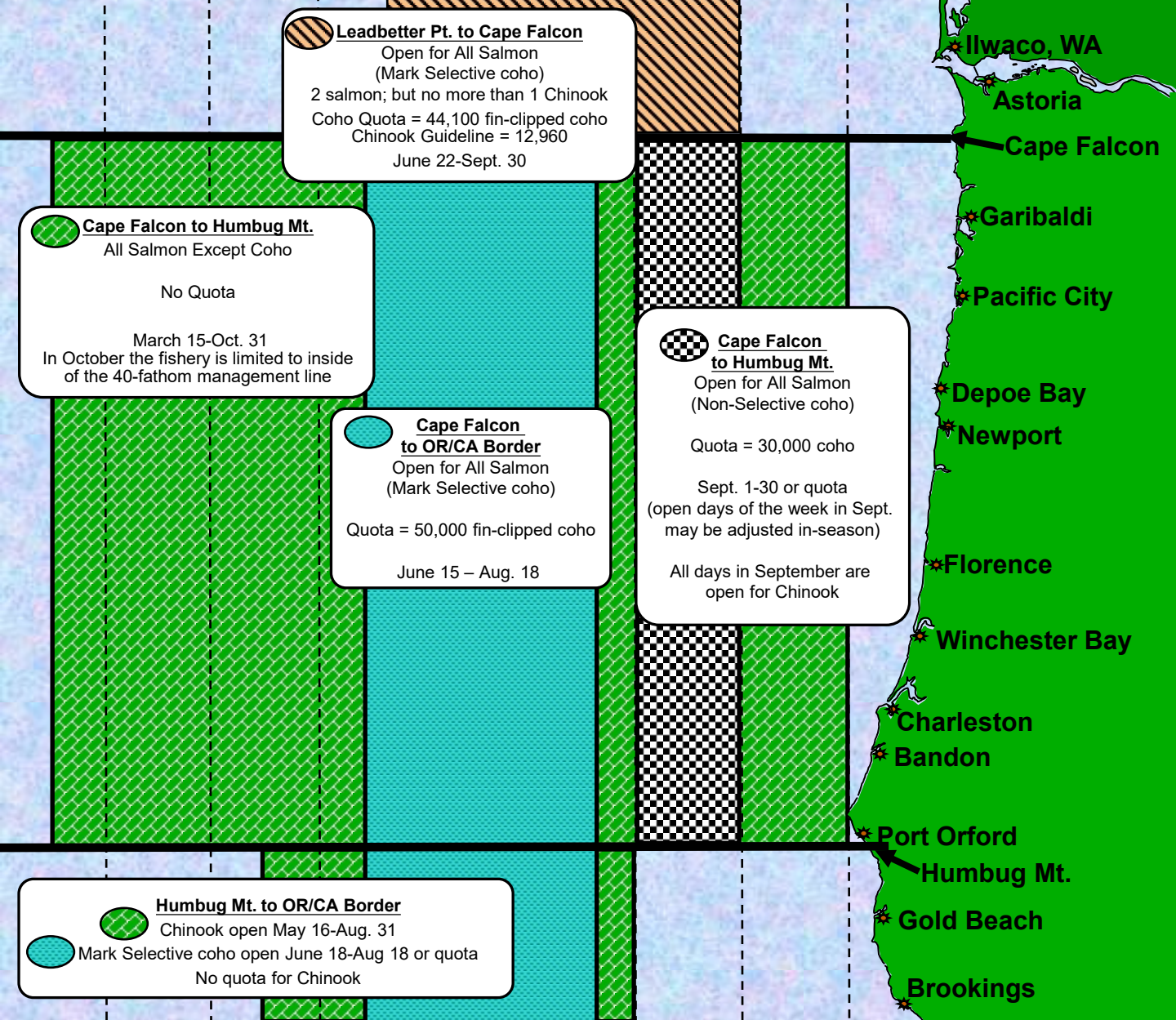
Summary Graphics of the 2024 Ocean Salmon Season Alternatives for Recreational and Commercial Troll Seasons off Oregon as Adopted at the Pacific Fishery Management Council on March 11, 2024

Oregon Ocean Commercial Troll Salmon Alternative 1 - 3/11/2024



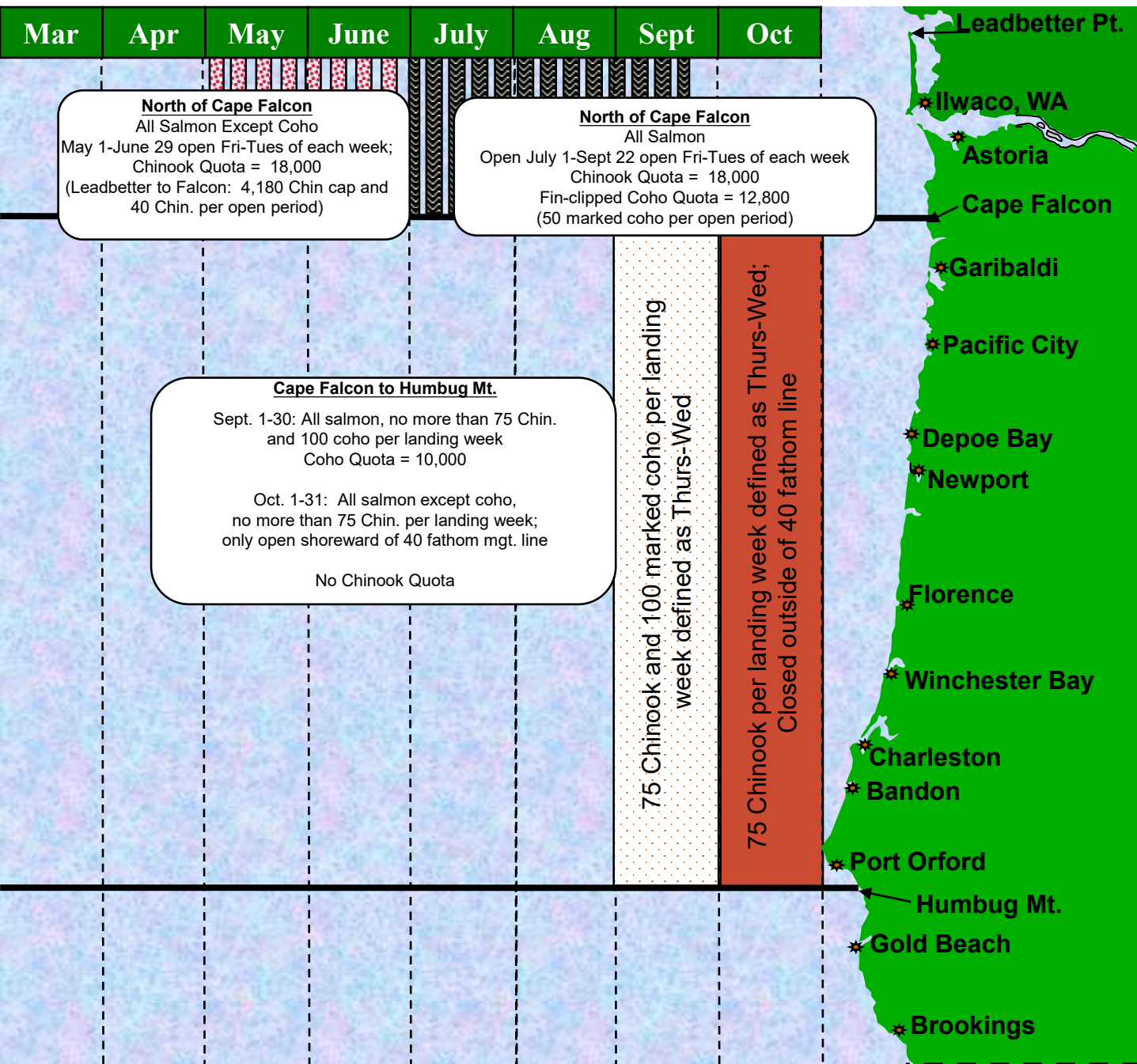
