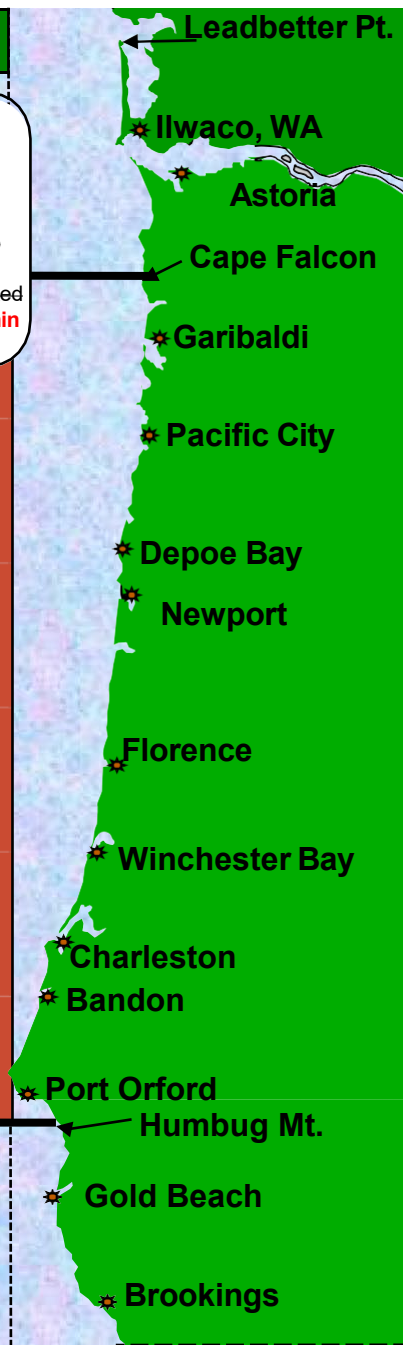
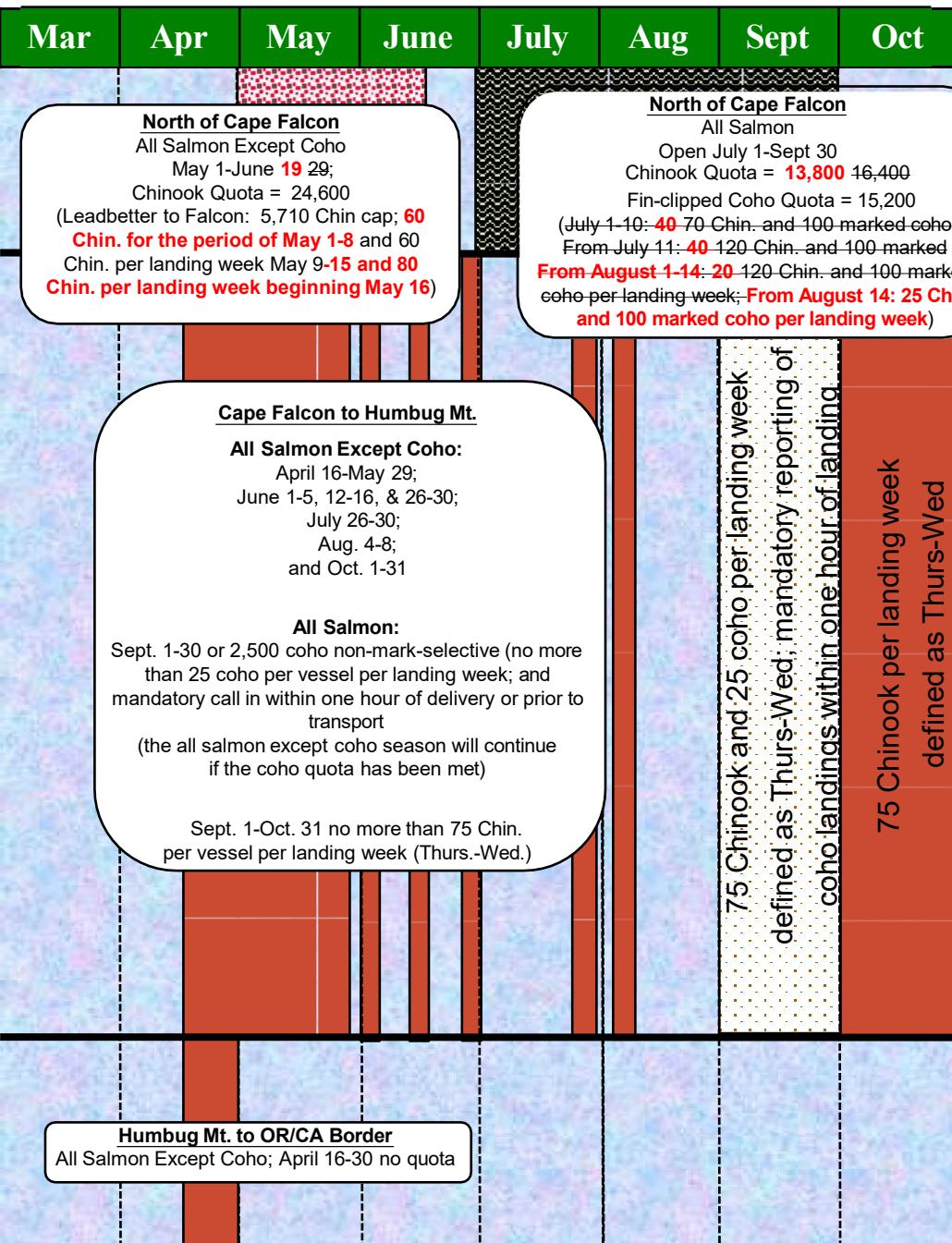


2024 Oregon Ocean Commercial Troll Salmon Seasons



North of Cape Falcon
 All Salmon Except Coho
 May 1-June 19 29;
 Chinook Quota = 24,600
 (Leadbetter to Falcon: 5,710 Chin cap; **60 Chin. for the period of May 1-8** and 60 Chin. per landing week May 9-15 and **80 Chin. per landing week beginning May 16**)





North of Cape Falcon
 All Salmon
 Open July 1-Sept 30
 Chinook Quota = **13,800** 16,400
 Fin-clipped Coho Quota = 15,200
 (July 1-10: **40** 70 Chin. and 100 marked coho
 From July 11: **40** 120 Chin. and 100 marked
From August 1-14: 20 120 Chin. and 100 marked
 coho per landing week; **From August 14: 25 Chin and 100 marked coho per landing week**)

Cape Falcon to Humbug Mt.
All Salmon Except Coho:
 April 16-May 29;
 June 1-5, 12-16, & 26-30;
 July 26-30;
 Aug. 4-8;
 and Oct. 1-31
All Salmon:
 Sept. 1-30 or 2,500 coho non-mark-selective (no more than 25 coho per vessel per landing week; and mandatory call in within one hour of delivery or prior to transport
 (the all salmon except coho season will continue if the coho quota has been met)
 Sept. 1-Oct. 31 no more than 75 Chin. per vessel per landing week (Thurs.-Wed.)

75 Chinook and 25 coho per landing week defined as: Thurs-Wed; mandatory reporting of coho landings within one hour of landing

75 Chinook per landing week defined as Thurs-Wed

Humbug Mt. to OR/CA Border
 All Salmon Except Coho; April 16-30 no quota

-  All salmon except coho. Vessels landing south of Leadbetter Pt., WA may only fish South of Leadbetter Pt. Vessels fishing north of Leadbetter Pt., must land their catch north of Leadbetter Pt. Landings restricted to within the open area and Garibaldi only. Must land all catch within 24 hours of any closure. Chinook 27" minimum length. All landings into Oregon must be reported within one hour of landing at (541)857-2546 or to nfalcon.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov Landing week defined as Thursday-Wednesday.
-  All salmon, all coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. Vessels landing south of Leadbetter Pt., WA may only fish south of Leadbetter Pt. Vessels fishing north of Leadbetter Pt., must land their catch north of Leadbetter Pt. Landings restricted to within the open area and Garibaldi only. Must land all catch within 24 hours of any closure. Chinook 27" and coho 16" minimum length. All landings into Oregon must be reported within one hour of landing at (541)857-2546 or to nfalcon.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov Landing week defined as Thursday-Wednesday.
-  All salmon except coho. All fish must be landed into Oregon. No more than 4 spreads per wire. Chinook 28" minimum length. No more than 75 Chinook per vessel per landing week (Thurs.-Wed.) in September and October.
-  All salmon. All fish must be landed into Oregon. No more than 4 spreads per wire. Chinook 28" min. length. Coho 16" min. length. All landings of coho in Oregon must be reported within one hour of landing at (541)857-2546 or to nfalcon.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov Landing week defined as Thursday-Wednesday.

Incidental Troll Halibut: 1 Pacific Halibut per each 2 Chinook landed up to 35 halibut per trip (1 halibut may be landed without meeting the ratio). Minimum size of 32 inches total length.
