



ODFW QUALIFYING DEPREDAATION REPORT

Investigation ID: 131015 Wallowa

Investigation ID# 131015 Wallowa was confirmed by ODFW as a wolf-caused depredation incident. This depredation occurred inside an Area of Known Wolf Activity (Snake River Pack posted on 7/8/2013). The livestock was lawfully present on a public lands USFS grazing allotment. This is the first confirmed depredation in this area.

Unnatural Attractants: The livestock producer provided a written statement that that he did not know of any unnatural attractants of potential wolf-livestock conflict in this area.

Non-lethal Measures: The animal was not in a reasonably protectable situation. Rather, it was in an open range situation on a large forest allotment pasture. Therefore the landowner or lawful occupant is not required to have been using at least one measure ODFW deems most appropriate from non-lethal deterrence measures identified pursuant to OAR 635-110-0010(7)(b)(D) to protect calving operations, nursing cattle, sheep operations, or other reasonably protectable situations. However, in this situation the producer did report to ODFW that he had non-injuriously hazed wolves on the 14th in this area, and had returned on the morning of the 15th to check cattle.

Qualification Status: This confirmed incident of depredation qualifies under OAR 635-110-0010(8).
