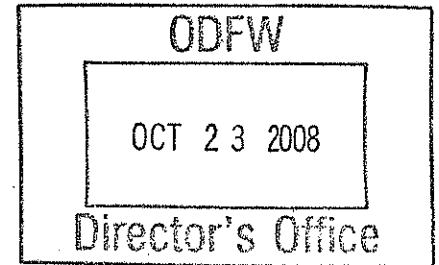

1. Petitioner's name is Richard Wood. The petitioner is the owner of Yaquina Bait Company, 138 SE 35<sup>th</sup> St., South Beach, OR, 97366. Phone number: 541.270.3336.
2. The following people are known to the petitioner to be interested in the adoption of the new rule outlined below: see attached signature sheet.
3. The petitioner asserts that under the amended rules (OAR 635-004-0025 and 635-004-0042) made in August, 2009 by the Oregon Fish and Wildlife Commission, the harvesting of anchovies in select inland waters for bait are too restrictive. The petitioner feels the amendments made limit opportunity for the harvest of live bait in select inland waters by restricting the harvest of inland anchovies to the commercial fishing catching vessels only. The amendments effectively prohibit the commercial harvest of inland anchovies for sale as bait by a second party. The petitioner maintains the amendments reduce the opportunity for refilling of live anchovy bait in Oregon to only a fraction of the live bait albacore fishing boats that could potentially benefit.
4. The petitioner proposes creating a new rule to create a limited entry inland anchovy bait fishery in Yaquina Bay for the purpose of resale.
5. The new rule the petitioner proposes to create would include the following provisions:

(NEW RULE) Limited Entry Inland Anchovy Bait Fishery

- (1) One permit available in Yaquina Bay to harvest and sell anchovies as live bait from May 15 through October 31.
  - a. Permit only issued to a licensed bait company.
  - b. Permit holder must obtain a bait fishing license and a commercial fishing license.
- (2) Harvesting methods for the taking of anchovies include:
  - (a) Purse seine
  - (b) Lampara net; or
  - (c) Hook and line "jigging."

(3) All species other than anchovies, taken in operation of gear authorized by this rule, must be returned to the water immediately unharmed.

(4) Permit holder is responsible for maintaining a logbook and report actual pounds harvested upon sale of anchovies.

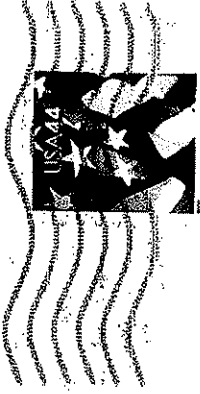
