- More than \$6 million in reductions
- 44 positions affected
- 60% of the affected positions are currently vacant
- 6% reduction in headquarters positions
- 2% reduction in field positions

Positions Affected by Pacific Coastal Salmon Recovery Fund (PCSRF) Reductions

- Fund shift PCSRF from Western Oregon Stream Restoration Program and Habitat Conservation Program to Columbia and Coastal Fish Status and Trend Monitoring in Policy Option Package 112
- 16 positions affected
- 25% of the affected positions are currently vacant
