Commercial Fishery Permit Board Member Appointments

- Must be in good standing within the community
- Serve staggered 3 year terms
- May not serve more than two consecutive terms
- Board members representing a particular fishery must hold a valid permit in that fishery.

Commercial Fishery Permit Board Member Appointments

- **Positions to appoint**
 - **Three members to represent each of the following fisheries:**
 - Columbia River Gillnet Salmon
 - Ocean Troll Salmon
 - Yaquina Bay Roe-Herring
 - Blue/Black Rockfish and Nearshore
 - Sardine
 - Bay Clam Dive
 - Brine Shrimp
 - Sea Urchin
 - Sardine
 - Ocean Dungeness crab
 - **Two members to represent the public at large**

Options for Commercial Fishery Permit Board Member Appointments

- 1. Approve all nominations as recommended by staff in Option 1, with the exception of the Blue and Black Rockfish and Nearshore fishery and the Ocean Dungeness crab fishery. For these two fisheries there were more nominees than board positions available:
 - Staff recommendation for the Blue and Black Rockfish and Nearshore fishery is to appoint Aaron Longton, Brett Webb and Linden Skoog. While all the nominees were qualified, this appointment would provide some geographical diversity for the fishery.
 - Staff recommendation for the Ocean Dungeness Crab fishery is to appoint Joel Purkey and Darus Peake. While all the nominees were qualified, this recommendation is based on of their high level of involvement in the fishery.
- 2. Approve some of the nominations and appoint selected members.
- 3. Approve none of the nominations.
