Modeling Updates (page 8)

1. Updated analyses incorporating loss of funding authorized through SB830 (2013), codified at ORS 508.980, is based on Governor Brown's expressed concern that existing Columbia River reform rules "put at risk ongoing funding", Senator Girod's concern as one of the original sponsors of SB830 that "it will be difficult to sustain the \$4 million in general fund and Columbia River endorsement fees", as well as input from other legislative sponsors of SB830 (see Attachments 4, 6, 7, and 8 [~~and 9~~]).

Model Outputs and Assessment of Options (page 9)

2. This includes assuming implementation without regard to non-concurrence and funding risks, as well as likely implementation incorporating non-concurrence and funding risks, based on staff's best professional judgement (Attachment 9 [~~10~~]).
