# Petition to Split the Central Coast Halibut Area

## Introduction:

The Oregon Coast Anglers are petitioning the ODFW Commissioners to split the Central Coast Halibut Area into two areas, with area specific quota allocations. The result would be:

- North Central Coast Area (NCCA) from Cape Falcon to the North Jetty of Florence
- South Central Coast Area (SCCA) from the North Jetty of Florence to Humbug Mountain
- An equitable split for the halibut quota of 80% for NCCA and 20% for SCCA.
- The split should be made as soon as ODFW procedures will allow.

This petition to the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) Commissioners has the support of a wide variety of south central coast business and angling stakeholders.

## Rationale:

Splitting the Central Coast Halibut Area will improve the distribution of angling effort and have a positive economic impact within the area. This approach provides ODFW with better management of the halibut quota in that the entire central coast area (most of Oregon's Coast) would not have to be shut down. Depending on quota achievement NCCA could be shut down and the SCCA could still be providing angling opportunity, or vice versa. SCCA anglers would have more Halibut fishing opportunity and longer seasons, which will attract more anglers to Oregon's Southern Ports, resulting in more fishing license sales for ODFW and more income for related businesses.

## Major Causals:

Demographics – The US Census Bureau in 2010 estimated Oregon's population at 3.7 million with 50% living around Portland and 75% of the population above Lane County. By 2020 Oregon's population is forecasted to exceed 4 million with most of the growth in counties surrounding Portland.

Nature – The SCCA Ports (Florence, Winchester Bay, Coos Bay and Bandon) are all fed by major river systems creating hazardous bar crossing conditions for boats attempting ocean access. Newport in the North is a large bay with little river flow and provides generally easy access to the ocean.

## Background and Justification for 20% of the Halibut quota for SCCA:

Pacific Ocean and Oregon river bar conditions often prevent southern anglers from leaving port. While SCCA anglers can't get out, NCCA anglers (particularly Newport) with milder conditions catch most (88%) of the Central Coast Halibut Area quota. ***This leaves SCCA anglers with only a 12 % share and shortened seasons.*** This is clearly proven by the last ten years of ODFW's Sport Pacific Halibut Estimate Data (Attachment A). In the last ten years, 2008 was the only year the SCCA season wasn't truncated early by the Newport and NCCA angler's catch. In 2008, SCCA anglers caught 21 % of the Halibut Spring All Depth Season quota and had the most days of opportunity for the spring and summer seasons.

The 80 / 20 quota split leaves the NCCA with the vast majority of the halibut, while reserving just 20% for SCCA to spread over the days when ocean access is actually possible. Any unfulfilled quotas would be reallocated by ODFW to other zones and seasons, as they do now. This improved SCCA opportunity would result in a more distributed fishing effort and longer seasons with the associated positive impact to the local economy.

**For Example: Let's apply the 80/20 split to 2017 Central Coast Area Halibut fishing results:**

The Spring Halibut Season had the most quota of the three seasons, 151,712 lbs, and ran for six weekends in 2017 (Thursday – Saturday) ending on July 1st. NCCA would have met or exceeded their quota (80% - 121,370 lbs) on June 30th. SCCA's quota would have been 30,342 lbs and their season could have lasted to July 15<sup>th</sup>, an additional three days of fishing or more.

The Summer Halibut Season quota was 66,281 lbs in 2017 and ran four weekends (Friday – Saturday) ending on September 16<sup>th</sup>. NCCA's quota (80% - 53,025 lbs) would have been met or exceeded on September 15th. SCCA's quota would have been 13,256 lbs and could have lasted through October, providing an additional six days of fishing.

The Nearshore Halibut Season quota was 35,631 lbs and ran 18 weeks in 2017, seven days a week, ending on October 29th. However, ODFW closed the Nearshore Halibut Season on July 30<sup>th</sup> for one month and reopened on September 3<sup>rd</sup>, because the original quota had been met. ODF&W added 6,734 lbs to the Nearshore quota and reopened the season. NCCA's quota (80% - 28,505 lbs) would have been met by October 8th. SCCA's quota would have been 7,126 lbs and could have lasted to the end of the season, October 31<sup>st</sup>. The closure would not have been necessary for SCCA and an additional thirty four days of fishing could have been possible.

In summary SCCA anglers caught 16.6% of the total Central Coast Area Halibut (all seasons combined) for 2017. Fishing to a 20% quota could have increased SCCA fishing seasons by forty three days. Applying this logic to earlier years, particularly 2015, 2014 and 2013, SCCA halibut fishing seasons would have been increased by much more than forty three days.

**Safety at Sea:**

Longer halibut fishing seasons will stop the “derby” mentality which results from short seasons. Knowing that they have limited days available to catch halibut, SCCA anglers take risks. Because the best halibut locations are many miles out, SCCA anglers need to get an early start for the hours of cruising time necessary. Often the river bars are crossed on Ebb Tides, when the worst conditions prevail. Ocean swell and wind chop are also cause for concern. Longer halibut seasons for SCCA anglers would lessen the pressure, enabling anglers to choose safer conditions for their fishing adventures.

**Spreading the Fishing Opportunity and Relieving Pressure:**

There are thousands of anglers fishing for Halibut from Newport, many more than all the Oregon Ports combined, as documented in ODFW Halibut Angler Trips (Attachment B). In the last three years thousands more angler trips were made than in any of the prior years. As mentioned earlier, the population in northern Oregon is expected to increase in the future, and will likely result in even more angler trips out of Newport. Splitting the Central Coast Halibut Area would relieve some of the pressure on the Halibut fishing grounds accessed by Newport anglers.

Increased SCCA halibut fishing opportunity due to longer seasons will reduce pressure on quota restricted ground fish. Current ODFW regulations prohibit fishing for ground fish, while halibut fishing. Therefore, anglers engaged in halibut fishing won't be bottom fishing for ground fish. Halibut fishing is and will be more important as salmon and bottom fishing are more and more constrained, as they were last year and are this year.

**Smaller Fishing Areas are not new business:**

Both the North Coast Halibut Area and the South Coast Halibut Area are much smaller than the Central Coast Halibut Area. Even with the proposed split of the central area, they are smaller. The central area was previously split and it would have remained split, if the quota had been adequate.

Last year the Central Coast Salmon Area was split at Florence. This split affected the commercial salmon anglers last year, and could impact commercial and recreational anglers in future years.

Smaller fishing areas allow ODFW to manage the area based on issues found in that area, which may not affect other areas. This year ODFW has proposed to reduce the number of halibut fishing days in the Northern Halibut Area (above Cape Falcon) to enable longer seasons.

**Conclusion:**

Splitting the Central Coast Halibut Area will provide more angling opportunity with improved economic impact for SCCA ports. "Good fishing is good for business", states Rick Beck, Owner, Winchester Bay Market.

Eliminating the dire effects of early fishing season closures is critical for local commerce. Bottom fishing inside 30 fathoms was completely shut down September 17<sup>th</sup> in 2017. The impact of this closure was immediately felt in the southern ports and angling dependent businesses. Tackle shops and charter boat services laid off employees and cut hours. Halibut fishing is also affected by closures. In nine of the last ten years (2008 exception) the Central Coast Halibut Area fishing seasons were closed early due to Newport angler harvest.

ODFW management of four halibut sub areas is not that much more difficult than the three already managed. The precedent for managing four areas was set back in 1995. Halibut quotas are set annually for the sub areas and rebalanced from season to season and area to area based on harvest results. This is normal business for ODFW.

Risks are essentially non-existent and the rewards are obvious. Minimal losses to the NCCA will be more than offset by significantly extended fishing days and benefits in the SCCA. NCCA anglers are welcome to come south to fish!

**Summary:**

Spreading the halibut fishing effort is good for fish conservation and management. Splitting the Central Coast Halibut Area provides ODFW additional opportunities to more effectively manage Oregon's fishing resources, reducing the need for broad area coastal shutdowns.

Splitting the Central Coast Halibut Area is good for anglers, ODFW, fish conservation, local businesses, and Oregon!


