



1 ([a]b) Each organization is limited to five tags total for all species except black bear per  
2 year.

3 ([b]c) Each organization is limited to two tags for black bear per year.

4 ([e]d) An individual tag entitles the holder to only one black bear, or one deer, or one elk, or  
5 one pronghorn antelope.

6 ([d]e) A qualified child **or qualified veteran** may obtain only one tag pursuant to this rule.

7 ([e]f) Tags issued under this rule may be used to hunt within any Oregon Wildlife  
8 Management Unit (as defined in OAR chapter 635 division 080), except specific area closures as  
9 identified in the current Oregon Big Game Regulations, Hart Mountain Antelope Refuge, or  
10 Starkey Experimental Forest enclosure.

11 ([4]g) A qualified child must be between 12 and 21 years of age at the time of the hunt~~[-and  
12 must comply with all requirements concerning:].~~

13 ([6]7) A qualified child under the age of 18 must hunt in the company of an adult 21 years of  
14 age or older.

15 ([5]8) A qualified child **or qualified veteran** may be either resident or non-resident **and**  
16 **must comply with all requirements concerning:**~~[-]~~

17 (a) Minimum hunting age (ORS 497.350);

18 (b) Hunter education (ORS 497.360);

19 (c) Hunting hours (OAR 635-065-0730);

20 (d) Holding a valid Oregon hunting license, and

21 (e) Using legal weapon for hunting the species for which the tag is issued.

22 ([7]9) For tags issued under this rule, open seasons are as follows:

23 (a) For deer, ~~and~~ **elk, and pronghorn antelope:** ~~[September]~~ **August** 1 through November  
24 30 of the year the tag is issued.

25 ~~[(b) For pronghorn antelope: August 1 through September 30 of the year the tag is issued.]~~

26 ([e]b) For spring black bear: April 1 through May 31 of the year the tag is issued.

27 ([d]c) For fall black bear: August 1 through December 31 of the year the tag is issued.
