Potential Concepts/Issues

- Deer/Elk
 - Standardization of deer bag limits
 - Consolidation of controlled hunts
 - Clearer controlled hunt boundary
 - Standard approach to weapon restrictions due to safety concerns
 - Address outliers hunts/regulations
 - Some new or expanded opportunities

Potential Concepts/Issues

- Sheep/Goat
 - Provide longer seasons
 - Move to set dates
 - Move or expand some seasons dates beyond August
 - Consolidate hunt areas where possible
 - Make boundary descriptions simpler
 - Identify opportunities to expand hunt areas

Potential Concepts/Issues

- Pronghorn
 - Move some seasons out of august timeframe
 - Review allocation of opportunity by weapon type
 - Consolidate hunt areas where possible
 - Expand bag limits in some hunts

Potential Concepts/Issues

- Bear
 - Consistent bear season dates
 - Expand area of additional fall bear tag
 - Consolidate spring hunt areas where possible

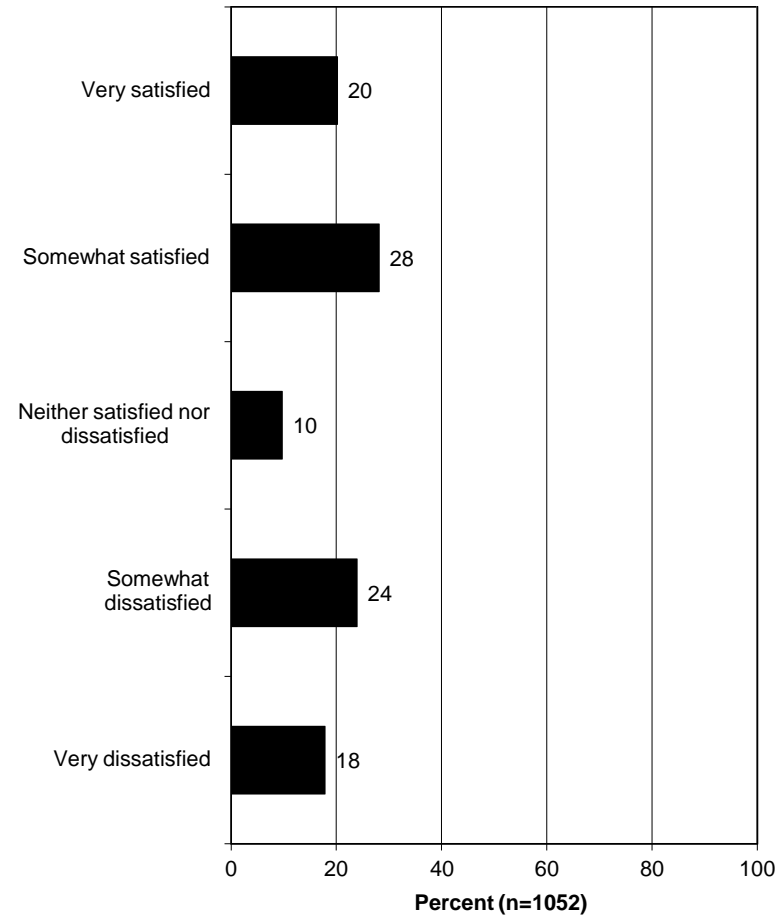
Potential Concepts/Issues

- Western Gray Squirrel
 - Simpler season structure
 - Set dates
 - Expand hunt area

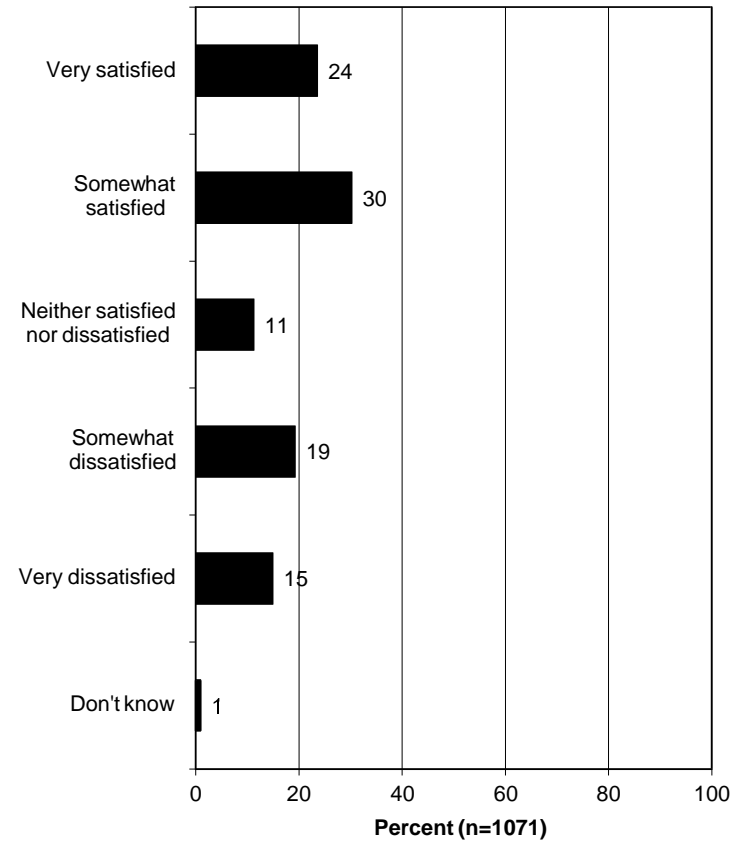
Hunter Survey

- Oregonians who have hunted or applied in past 3 years
- n=2,000 (1,000 deer hunters, 1,000 elk)
- Stratified by east/west residents
- Multimodal survey – phone, email, mail
- Final report late March
- Survey went great!

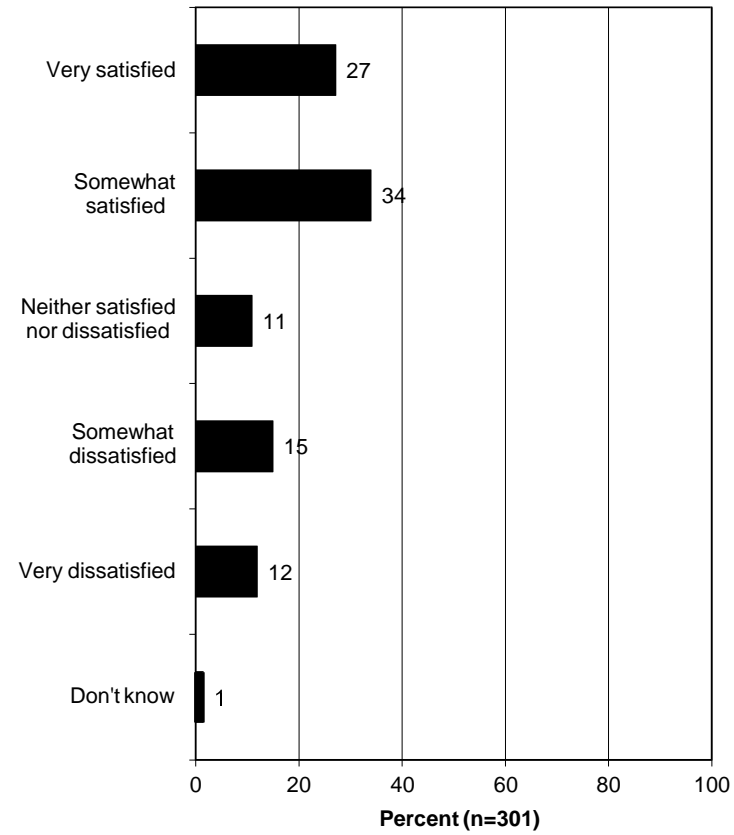

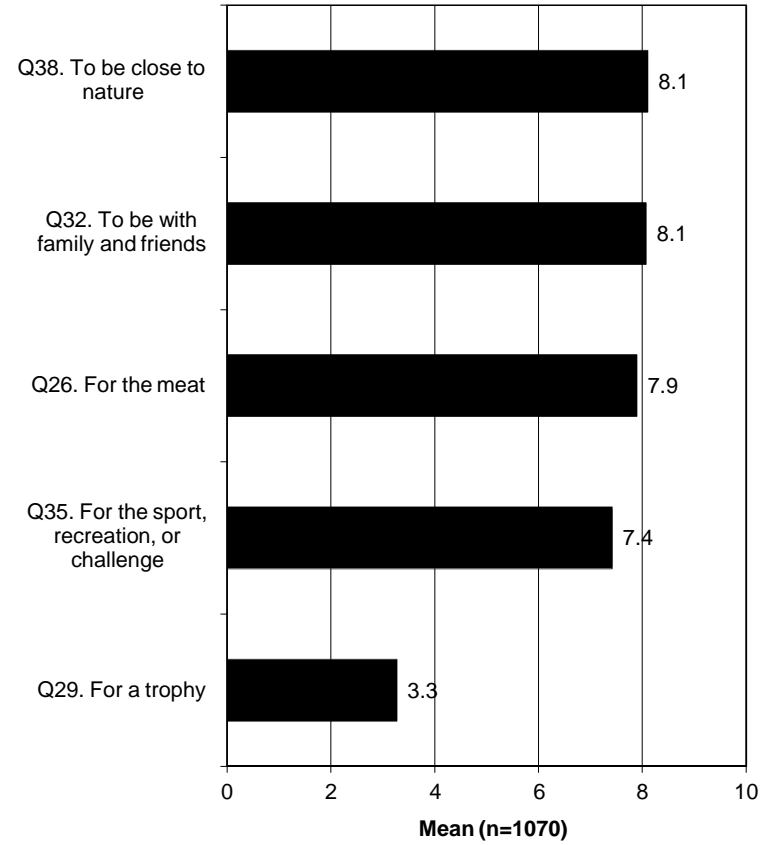

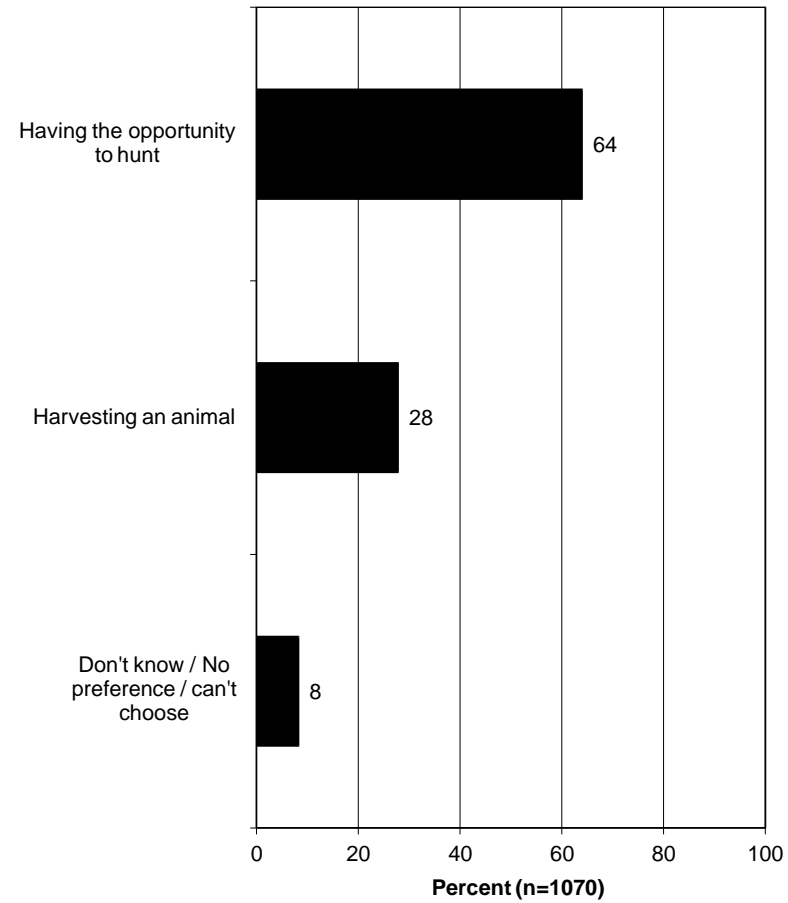

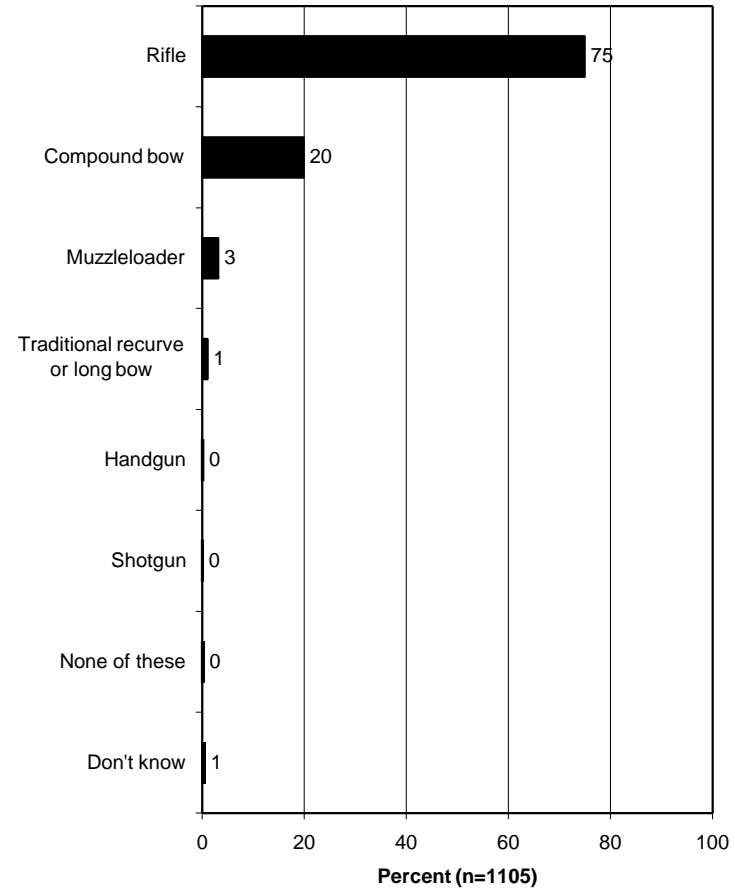

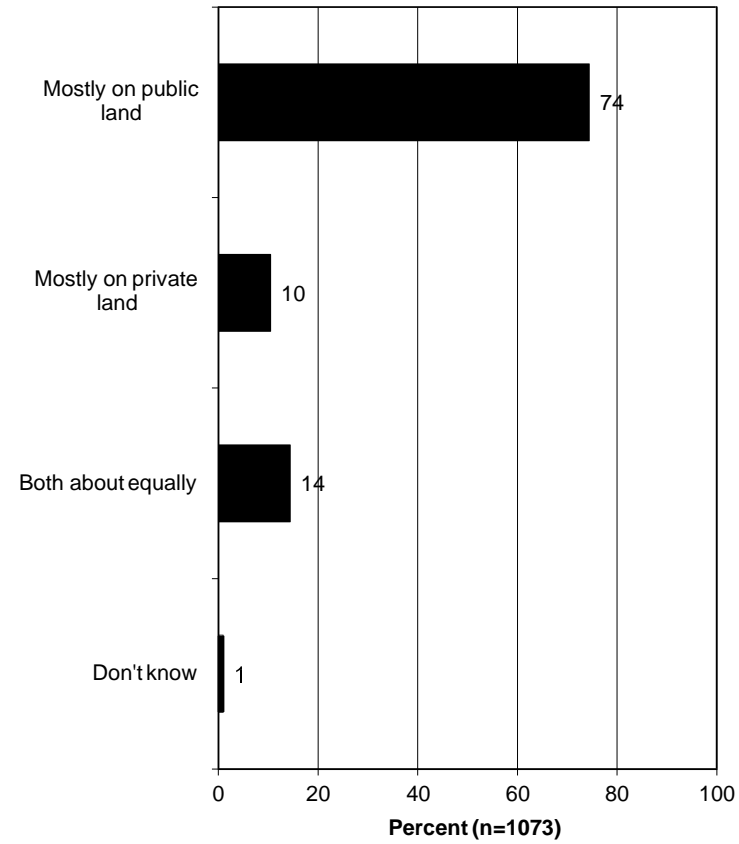
**Q198/Q199. In general, which is more important to you, personally, as a deer hunter in Oregon?
[Note: response order switched in each question.] (Deer survey)**



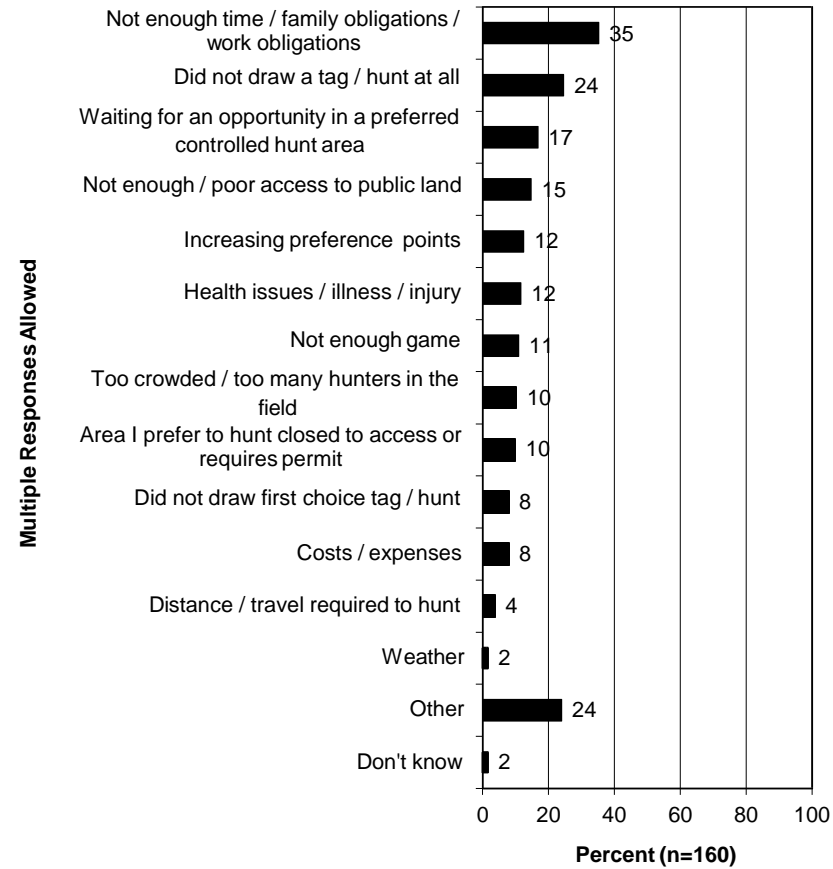
Q122. Of all weapons allowed, which one weapon would you most prefer to use to hunt elk in Oregon? (Elk hunters)



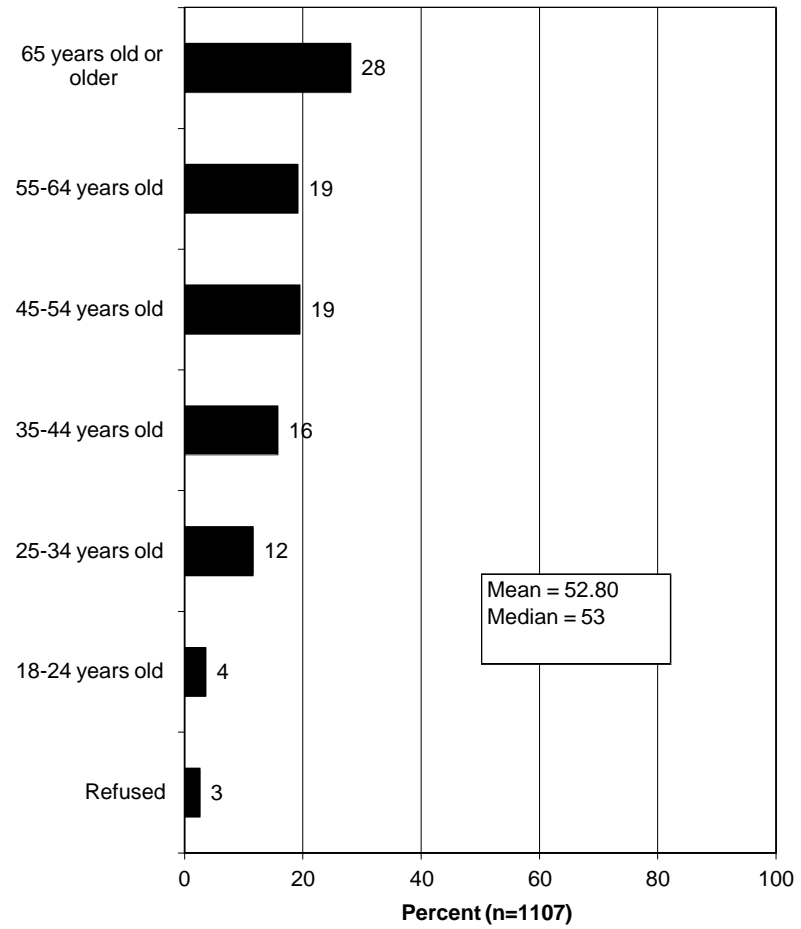
