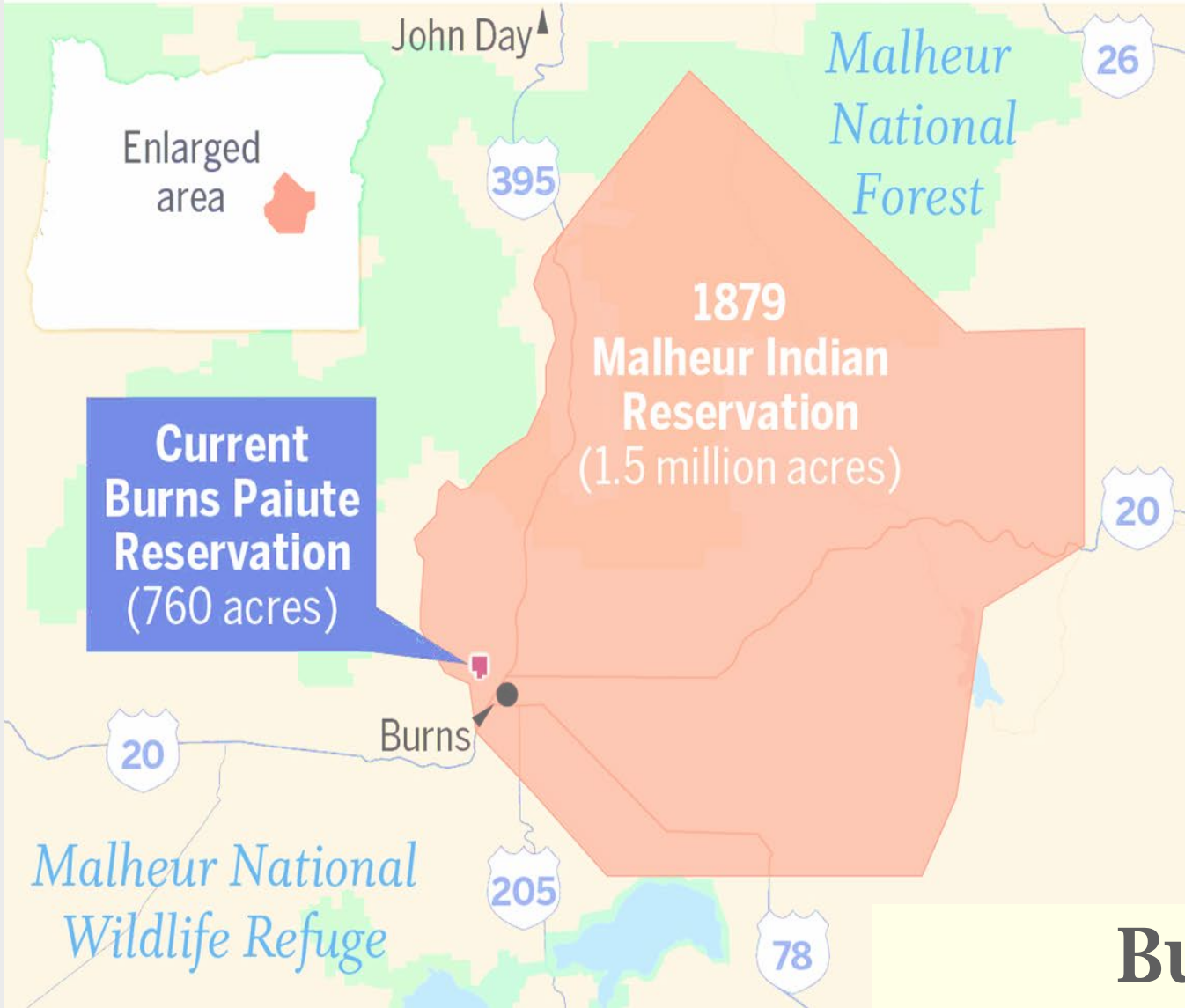

# Malheur Indian Reservation: Then and now



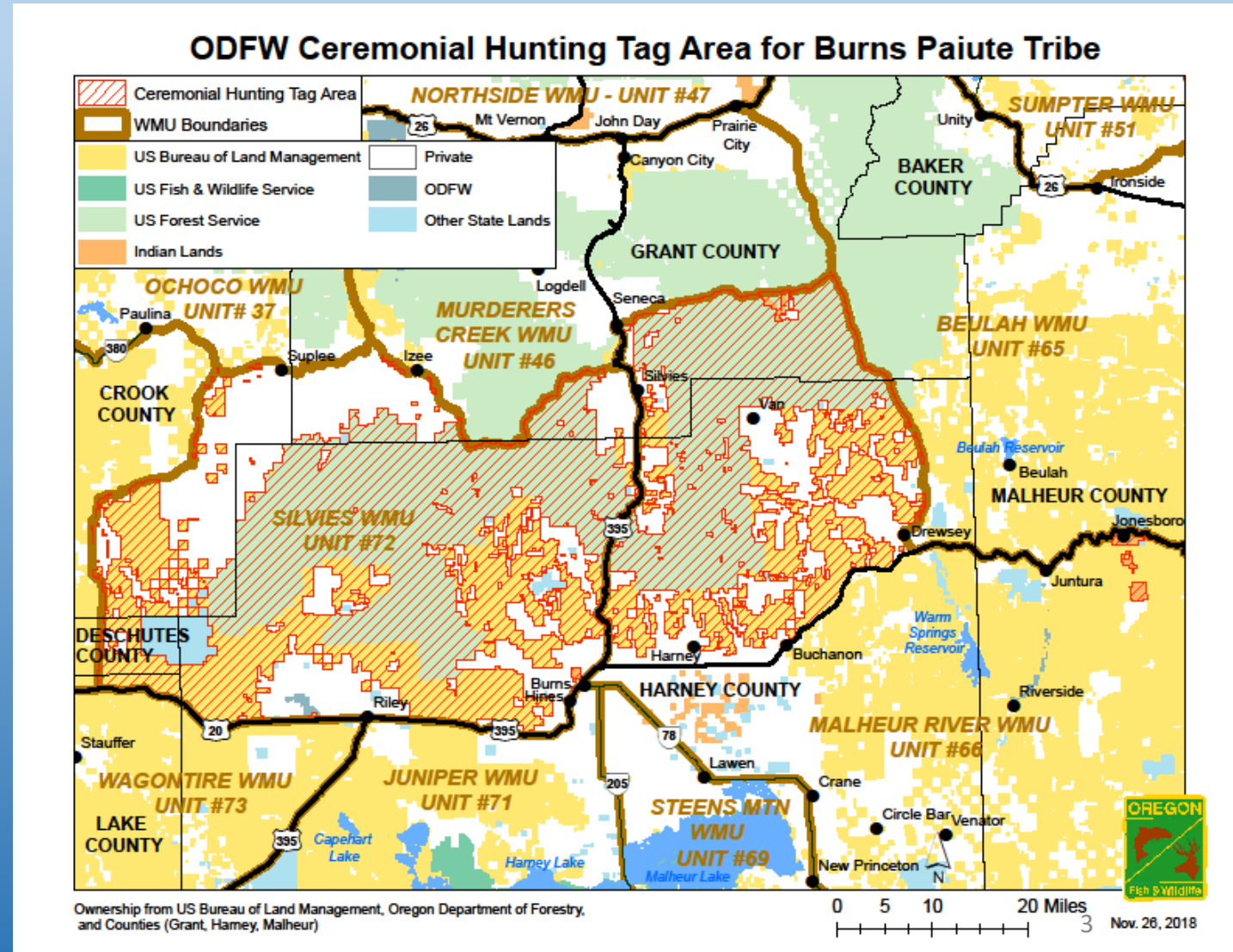

# Issue 1 - Hunting Tags

- Deer, elk and pronghorn
- Limited hunt area
- Specified season dates

## Proposed changes

- Increase elk tags to 15
- Expand season dates



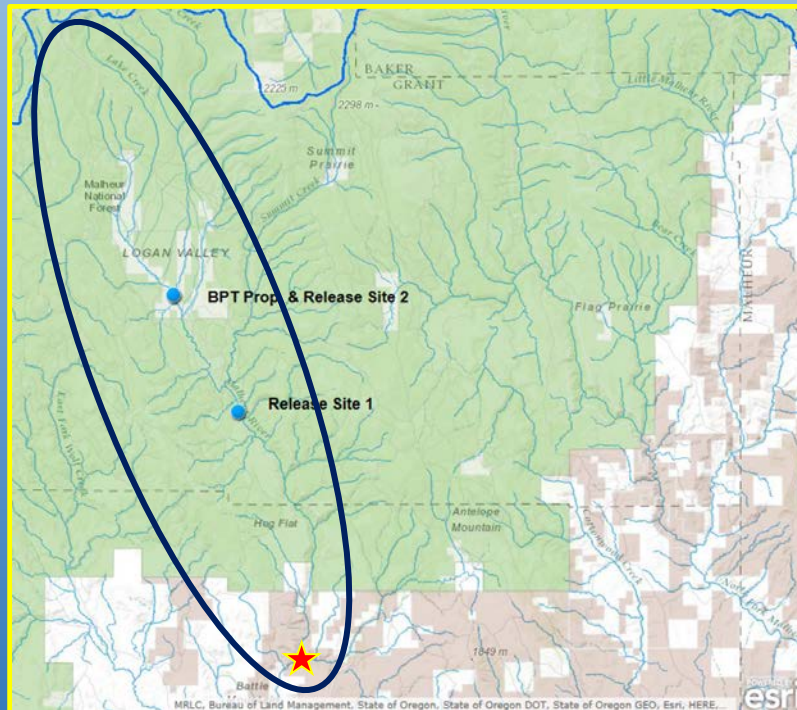
# Issue 2 – Spring Chinook Fishery

- Malheur River- Burns Paiute spring chinook fishery
- Oregon Administrative Rules
  - Division 21



# Issue 2 – Spring Chinook Fishery

- Mainstem Malheur River
  - Bluebucket Creek upstream to headwaters
    - Includes McCoy, Lake, Big, and Bosonberg Creeks
- June 1 – August 31



# Staff Recommendation

Amend OAR Chapter 635, Divisions 043 and 021 for ceremonial hunting and fishing opportunities by the Burns Paiute Tribe
