WHEREAS, the Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians (Coos) have negotiated a proposed agreement with the State of Oregon Fish and Wildlife Department on hunting and gathering; and

WHEREAS, the Siletz Tribal Council has reviewed the proposed agreement between the Coos Tribe and the State of Oregon Fish and Wildlife Department; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Siletz Tribal Council supports the proposed agreement between the Coos Tribe and the State of Oregon Fish and Wildlife Department; and

BE FINALLY RESOLVED, a copy of this Resolution shall be sent to the Coos Tribe and State of Oregon Fish and Wildlife Department.

Dear Commission Members:

I write on behalf of the Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Tribe of Indians ("Tribe"). The Tribe supports the proposed agreement for hunting, fishing, and trapping between ODFW and the Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua, and Siuslaw Indians ("CTCLUSI Agreement") and associated OAR.

Cow Creek strongly supports efforts of the State to recognize the hunting and fishing rights of Tribes and to develop co-management agreements for cooperative management of natural resources that are interest to both Tribal and State governments. It is critical that both Tribal and State agencies work on a government-to-government basis to manage fish and wildlife to ensure that there are healthy and harvestable levels of resources across the State. This agreement is a good example of how these efforts can be implemented. We appreciate your consideration of this letter.
