Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

Select Area Commercial Fisheries

- Rescinded or modified the previously adopted spring commercial salmon seasons by Compact action in concurrent OR/WA jurisdiction waters and by the state of Oregon or Washington in state waters.

Blind Slough/Knappa Slough Fishery (Zone 74)

- **Rescinded** the previously adopted spring season fishing periods:

7 PM to 7 AM (12 hours) on the following nights:

Thursday April 24 - Friday April 25 (1 night)

Monday April 28 - Tuesday April 29 (1 night)

Monday May 5 - Tuesday May 6 (1 night)

- **Modified** the lower boundary for spring season fishing periods currently scheduled in Knappa Slough for Thursday May 1 through Friday May 9, 2014. Modification in **bold**.

Delayed the implementation of the extended lower Knappa Slough boundary.

May 12 – June 13 the lower boundary of the Knappa Slough fishing area is extended downstream to boundary lines defined by markers on the west end of Minaker Island to markers on Karlson Island and the Oregon shore (fall boundary).

Tongue Point/South Channel Fishery (Zone 71)

- **Rescinded** the previously adopted spring season fishing periods:

7 PM to 7 AM (12 hours) on the following nights:

Thursday April 24 - Friday April 25 (1 night)

Monday April 28 - Tuesday April 29 (1 night)

Monday May 5 - Tuesday May 6 (1 night)

- **Modified** the previously adopted spring season fishing periods scheduled for Thursday May 1 through Friday May 9, 2014 as follows. Modifications in **bold**.

7 PM to **1 AM (6 hours)** on the following nights:

Youngs Bay Fishery (Zone 7)

- **Rescinded** the previously adopted spring season fishing periods:
 - 9 AM – 9 PM Monday April 28 (12 hours)
 - 9 AM – 9 PM Wednesday April 30 (12 hours)
 - 9 AM Monday May 5 – 3 AM Tuesday May 6 (18 hours)
 - 9 AM – 9 PM Wednesday May 7 (12 hours)
- **Modified** the previously adopted spring season fishing periods scheduled for Thursday May 1 and Thursday May 8, 2014 as follows. Modifications in **bold**.
 - 7 PM – 11 PM** Thursday May 1 (4 hours)
 - 1 PM – 7 PM** Thursday May 8 (6 hours)
