<sup>1</sup> Spring Chinook sport harvest from fisheries below Bonneville Dam (mainstem and Select Area), mainstem from Bonneville Dam upstream to the Oregon-Washington state line, plus Washington waters of the lower Snake River. Summer Chinook sport harvest from mainstem fisheries from the Astoria-Megler Bridge to Chief Joseph Dam, plus Washington tributaries upstream of Priest Rapids Dam. Fall Chinook and Coho sport harvest from mainstem fisheries from Buoy 10 to the Hwy 395 Bridge near Pasco, Washington, plus the Hanford Reach. Summer steelhead sport harvest from mainstem fisheries from Buoy 10 to the Hwy 395 Bridge, plus tributary "dip-ins".

<sup>2</sup> Harvest from mainstem and Select Area commercial fisheries. Steelhead retention in non-treaty commercial fisheries prohibited since 1975.

<sup>3</sup> Harvest from treaty commercial and ceremonial/subsistence fisheries. Spring Chinook, Summer Chinook, and Coho harvest includes jacks.

<sup>4</sup> Upriver A- and B-Index summer steelhead.
