

**Umpqua River (mainstem), Smith River
(mainstem, Douglas Co.), and North Fork
Smith River (Douglas Co.)
Fall 2024 Salmon/Steelhead Seasons**

Chinook: Open July 1-Nov. 30 on Umpqua Rvr from visible tip of the jetties to the North and South Umpqua confluence (use of bait allowed), Smith River from mouth to Spencer Creek, and North Fork Smith River from mouth to Johnson Creek. See below for wild Chinook seasonal limit bag limits; hatchery Chinook may be harvested as part of adult and jack salmon bag limit in waters open for Chinook.

Hatchery steelhead: Open all year in areas open for Chinook described above.

Hatchery steelhead, hatchery coho salmon, pink salmon and sockeye salmon may be harvested as part of the adult and jack salmon bag limit in waters open for Chinook or steelhead.

Overall salmon/steelhead bag limit in zone: Adults: 2 per day, 20 per year. Jacks: 5 per day (no annual limit)

Wild Chinook seasonal limit: 1 per day, 5 for season in aggregate for these waterbodies.

Wild coho daily and season limit: Umpqua River (mainstem) from the mouth to Scottsburg Br (RM 27.5), open Sept. 14-Oct. 15. 1 adult per day, 1 jack per day, 3 adults for season in aggregate for these waterbodies. No more than 5 adult wild coho/entire coast per year.
