

Salmon River

Fall 2024 Salmon/Steelhead Seasons

Chinook: Open Aug. 1-Dec. 31 from mouth to bridge near MP 9 on Hwy 18. From Sept. 1-Dec. 31 restricted to single point hook metal-based lures, fly fishing or bobber fishing from Knight Park boat ramp to bridge near MP 9. Closed to salmon angling from bridge near MP9 to confluence with Sulphur Creek. See below for wild Chinook seasonal limit bag limits; hatchery Chinook may be harvested as part of adult and jack salmon bag limit in waters open for Chinook.

Hatchery steelhead: Open from mouth to Sulphur Cr. Aug. 1-Dec. 31, may also retain 1 wild steelhead per day and 3 per year.

Hatchery steelhead, hatchery coho salmon, pink salmon and sockeye salmon may be harvested as part of the adult and jack salmon bag limit in waters open for Chinook or steelhead.

Overall salmon/steelhead bag limit in zone:
Adults: 2 per day, 20 per year. Jacks: 5 per day (no annual limit)

Wild Chinook seasonal limit: 2 per day/10 per season.

No wild coho season.
