

Siletz River, Schooner Creek and Drift Creek (Siletz Basin, Lincoln Co.)

Fall 2024 Salmon/Steelhead Seasons

Chinook: Siletz Rvr open Aug. 1-Dec. 31 up to marker sign approx. 1200 ft above Ojalla Br, open Oct. 7-Dec. 31 from marker sign to Illahee boat ramp, use of bait allowed. Schooner Crk open Aug. 1-Dec. 31 mouth to Erickson Cr. Drift Crk open Aug. 1-Dec. 31 from mouth to steel bridge entering Mennonite Camp. See below for wild Chinook seasonal limit bag limits; hatchery Chinook may be harvested as part of adult and jack salmon bag limit in waters open for Chinook.

Hatchery steelhead: Siletz Rvr open all year to 900 ft below Siletz Falls (painted boulder). Schooner Crk open Aug. 1-Dec. 31. Drift Crk open Aug. 1-Dec. 31.

Hatchery steelhead, hatchery coho salmon, pink salmon and sockeye salmon may be harvested as part of the adult and jack salmon bag limit in waters open for Chinook or steelhead.

Overall salmon/steelhead bag limit in zone: Adults: 2 per day, 20 per year. Jacks: 5 per day (no annual limit)

Wild Chinook seasonal limit: 2 per day, 10 per season in aggregate for these waterbodies

Wild coho daily and season limit: Siletz Rvr open from mouth upstream to ODFW marker sign approx. 1200 feet upstream of the Ojalla Bridge from Sept. 14-Oct 6 and from mouth upstream to Illahee Boat Ramp Oct 7-Nov. 15. Drift Crk open Sept. 14 -Nov. 15 from the mouth upstream to steel bridge entering Mennonite Camp. Schooner Crk open Sept. 14-Nov. 15 from the mouth upstream to Erickson Creek. Bag limit: 1 adult per day, 1 jack per day, and 3 adults in aggregate for these waterbodies for the season. No more than 5 adult wild coho daily/entire coast per year.
