## 2026 Waterfowl Stamp



### BLUE-WINGED TEAL by Richard Clifton

Richard Clifton is a self-taught artist who has chosen acrylics as his medium. Waterfowl being one of his favorite subjects, he has gone on to paint 56 duck stamps for various states and is a two-time Federal Duck Stamp winner.

Richard's work has recently been displayed as part of the annual Southeastern Wildlife Exposition and the Easton Waterfowl Festival. He was honored as the featured artist for the Easton Waterfowl Festival in 2022. Richard's work has been chosen several times for the Ducks Unlimited (DU) National Art Package. Also, he has been named DU Artist of the Year four times and is the first to win in back-to-back years. He has appeared in the documentary "The Million Dollar Duck", and on "DU TV" in an episode about his wildlife art, conservation efforts, and waterfowl hunting on his farm. Richard continues to find inspiration from his farm and surrounding areas.
