2017 Waterfowl Stamp by Richard Clifton

Richard Clifton lives on a historic family farm adjoining the Prime Hook National Wildlife Refuge in Delaware where he is surrounded by inspiration for his art. He is a self-taught wildlife artist who has chosen acrylics as his medium. Waterfowl being one of his favorite subjects, he has gone on to paint 44 duck stamps for various states, including the 1996 Australian Duck Stamp and the 2007-08 Federal Duck Stamp. Richard's work has been displayed in many of the top wildlife art shows throughout the country. His work has appeared on magazine covers, t-shirts, and a beer stein for Coors Brewing Company. It has been engraved on shotguns for Ducks Unlimited and he was named the 2015 Ducks Unlimited Artist of the Year. He is a causal birder and an avid hunter of waterfowl, deer, and upland game and uses his experiences in the field as inspiration for his work.
