

**Prineville Sage-grouse LIT Sub-group - Remote Meeting**  
**3 November 2021**  
**Meeting Notes**

**Meeting Objectives:**

1. Review and update partners on the draft Prineville LIT Threats Reduction Plan (plan).
2. Present the draft work plan (actionable goals and objectives developed based on the Prineville LIT Threats Reduction Plan) and get input from partners.
3. Finalize a format for the work plan
4. Layout next steps

**Highlights**

- This was the first time partners were able to see all sections of the draft Threats Reduction Plan (TRP) in one document. We ran partners through the plan and provided an overview on each section. Some sections of the plan are still being developed.
- Emily then presented an outline of the work plan which will be used to synthesize information from the TRP to identify actionable goals and objectives the LIT (and/or partners of the LIT) might consider prioritizing. We used the Baker LIT's work plan as a template (see attachment).
- The sub-group decided the draft TRP is ready enough to share with all LIT participants.
- The sub-group also discussed the fact that the TRP (and work plan) will always be a living document that will require updates and revisions especially as we continue to collect input from partners; climatic conditions and ecological conditions change; and actions get implemented.
