

## Areas to refine/strengthen

**Needs precautionary principle explicitly stated**

**Need to define objectives and be clear how objectives would be met**

**Strengthen clear research directives on limiting factors and other areas**

**Needs more explicit actions to change conditions on the ground**

Implementation plan section needed including time frame

Need to be clear on ODFW authority and ability to accomplish objectives X2

**Feedback process for meeting the objectives**

**Format sequence could be clearer - could be more sequential**

**Need more info and clarity on the level of public engagement**

**Objectives on Page 10 need strengthening**

Need more sense of urgency around climate change, biodiversity crisis, etc.

Needs more language around collaboration to achieve ecosystem mgmt objectives

**need more specifics of the BMFL habitat, vegetation, etc.**

**Need more information in the report esp Economics**

**Need review from fed partners and ODFW staff**

Not a lot of discussion of broad scale trapping closures - X3 - no details on starting dates and duration and scale

**Beyond scope of federal lands in sections X2**

New positions in ODFW is off target - more capacity to do things could be a recommendation

Concern about BDAs as a tool - concern about water availability - other agencies are working on this in E OR

State agency recommendations - encourage how to better interface with habitat mgmt process such as objectives within federal system and forest plans - ways ODFW can help

Should include predator management and disease management as well

include increase food and dam building resources for beaver on federal lands

**Should be more info on relocation as part of restoration tool**

Harvest of beaver restrictions - how they compare to other states - where and why?

Can't select for male beavers - demonstrates lack of knowledge of trapping practices - may be other ways to manage trapping than a y/n decision

**Beavers valued for own sake and managed humanely**

**Need to refine any language around private lands - concern here**

Strengthen language around holistic management - moving away from single species management, in the context of how to get more benefits in context of climate change, biodiversity loss, and water scarcity

## Areas for more discussion

How to include info and recommendations that do not have full work group support

**Need to discuss topics that were not low-hanging fruit**

**Highlight areas of disagreement within the work group**

**specificity and level of detail x3**

Statement on humane treatment of animals

**Default status is closed to trapping**

Scale of recommendations, can be general, but where does ODFW expertise take over?
